The Quechan Tribal Council of the Fort Yuma Quechan Indian Tribe have made a decision to do our part to stop the spread in Yuma and Imperial Counties resulting in the closure of Casino, Dining, Bar and Hotel/Resort Operations beginning Monday, March 23 at 6 pm. At this time there are too many variables for us to commit to how long this closure is going to last. We will continue to monitor the situation and make a re-opening statement when we are safely able to do so. The Tribal Council in this decision to close is for the general health and well-being of the communities in Imperial, Yuma County, their guests and our dedicated employees.

We are proud to be part of a small community where everyone is pulling together to do their part. It is this spirit of cooperation and community support that will hopefully lead to a swift end and return to regular daily life. We will be here to welcome you back when that time comes.
